Can I have a receipt?	Você pode me dar um recibo?

## Exercise 2 | Dialogue (Diálogo)

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**Directions:** Read the dialogue aloud with your teacher.

**Mr. Thomas:** Excuse me, could you tell me **where I can exchange my money?**

**Mr. Thomas:** Oh, yes. Thanks.

*(At the money exchange counter)*

**Mr. Thomas:** US dollars. **Can I see the exchange rate?**

**Bank clerk:** Sure, the rate is here. How much would you like to change?

**Mr. Thomas:** \$1000, all to Hong Kong dollars. **Could you include some small change in it?**

**Bank clerk:** Sure, that'll be 785 HKD. Here you are.

**Mr. Thomas:** Thanks. **Can I have a receipt, too?**

**Bank clerk:** Here's the receipt, thank you very much!
