Flight attendant: It is above you, next to the **reading light**. It will drop down when we lose **cabin pressure**.

Mr. Thomas: Do we have **lifejackets** just in case?

Flight attendant: Yes, they are under your seat. Your **seat cushion** can also be used as a **flotation device**.

Mr. Thomas: I'm afraid the weather is not so good. What can I do to stay safe?

Flight attendant: You don't need to worry about it. Always make sure that your **seatbelt is fastened** when the seatbelt sign is turned on.

Mr. Thomas: Thanks for your guidance.
