I'd like to move to another room.	Eu gostaria de mudar de quarto.
Is there something wrong with it?	Há algum problema com o seu?
Does that room overlook the sea?	Aquele quarto tem vista para o mar?
I'll take it.	Vou ficar com ele.
The heater is not working.	O aquecedor não está funcionando.
The light bulb is not working.	A lâmpada não está funcionando.
The air conditioner is not working.	O ar condicionado não está funcionando.
The hot water is not working.	A água quente não está funcionando.
I'll be there shortly.	Eu vou estar ali logo.
