## Exercise 2 | Dialogue (Diálogo)

**Mr. Thomas:** Okay. Can I have the password? I'd like to use it here anyway.

**Receptionist:** Certainly. This is the password, sir. Here it is.

**Mr. Thomas:** Thanks.
